

## FEED BACK ANALYSIS AND RECOMMNDATIONS ACADEMIC YEAR 2017

Report on the feedback received from the teachers

Going through the feedback report submitted by the teachers on different aspects – syllabus content, time table, Library book, administration etc it has been observed that 65% of the teachers are moderately satisfied with the syllabus content, are satisfied over the optional papers provided in the syllabus of different subjects, 50% are of the opinion that the class routine is sufficient for completion of the syllabus within the stipulated time. However, there is dissatisfaction over library space and urinal facility. Administrator is friendly and approachable.

### Recommendations / Suggestions

1. More book and University journals should be purchased in the Library.
2. Sitting space for the teachers in the College Canteen should be increase to make it more spacious.
3. Urinal facility in the Teachers' Common Room should be improved with enough space and ventilation
4. During examinations students should be allowed to enter the college campus before 20 minutes of the commencement to check students writing on the desks and benches.
5. The salary of the ADHOC teachers should be uniform. Pay should be reasonable and satisfactory to motivate the teachers.
6. Students having less than 75 % attendance should not be allowed to sit for examinations.
7. Leave granted to teachers should be uniform.
8. Winter uniform should be clearly mentioned and proper.
9. Teacher's common room is to be made more spacious.
10. Indoor game ( Ludo, carom etc) to be provided in the girls and boys common room so that children keep themselves engage and stop loitering on the verandah which creates a problem when classes are going on.

### FEEDBACK OF GUARDIANS

The comments forwarded by the guardians in the feedback form shows the following picture on the different aspects of the college. Guardians are satisfied that the college is successful in providing adequate environment for teaching and library. Classes are regular and discipline is maintained within the college campus. However financial support for the needy children is not satisfactory.
