An analysis was done on the students' Feedback on Teacher performance in curricular aspects collected by the IQAC. The Committee on the basis of the analysis arrived at the following observation:


1. The communicative skills of the teachers were found satisfactory.

4. Teachers according to students were approachable, friendly, and informative.


Recommendations/ Suggestions


1. The teachers could act as mentors so that students can discuss their personal problems if they so desire.
